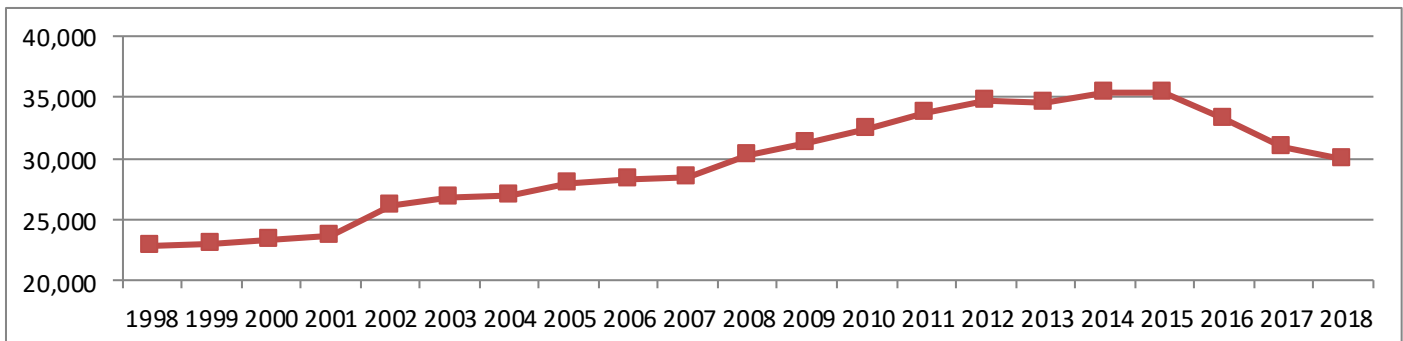

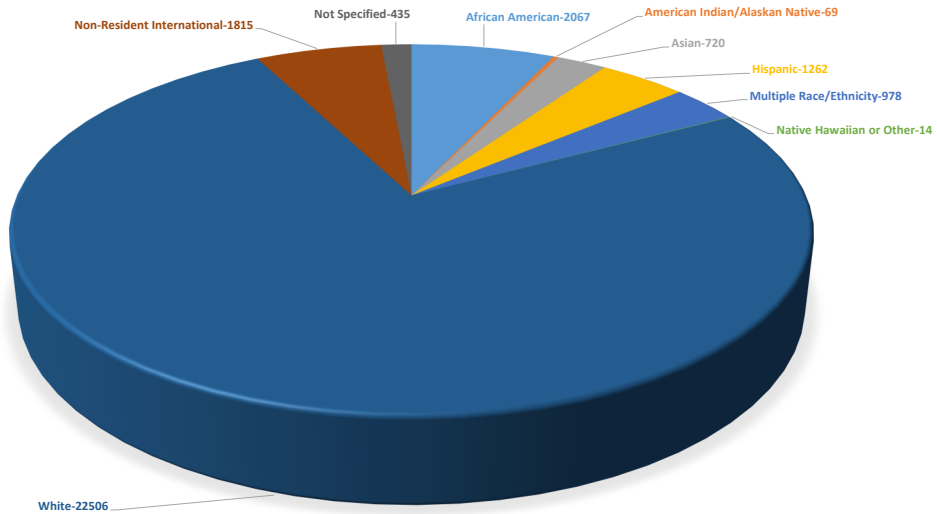
## Total Enrollment 1998-2018
